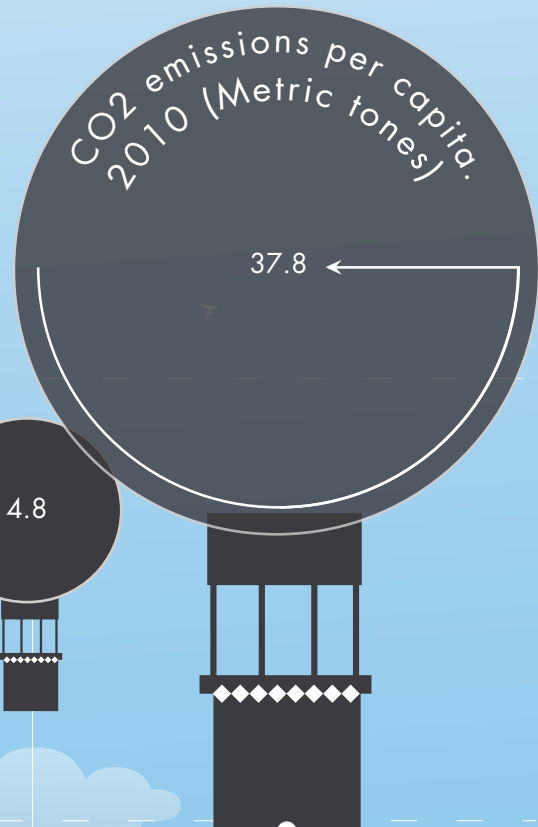

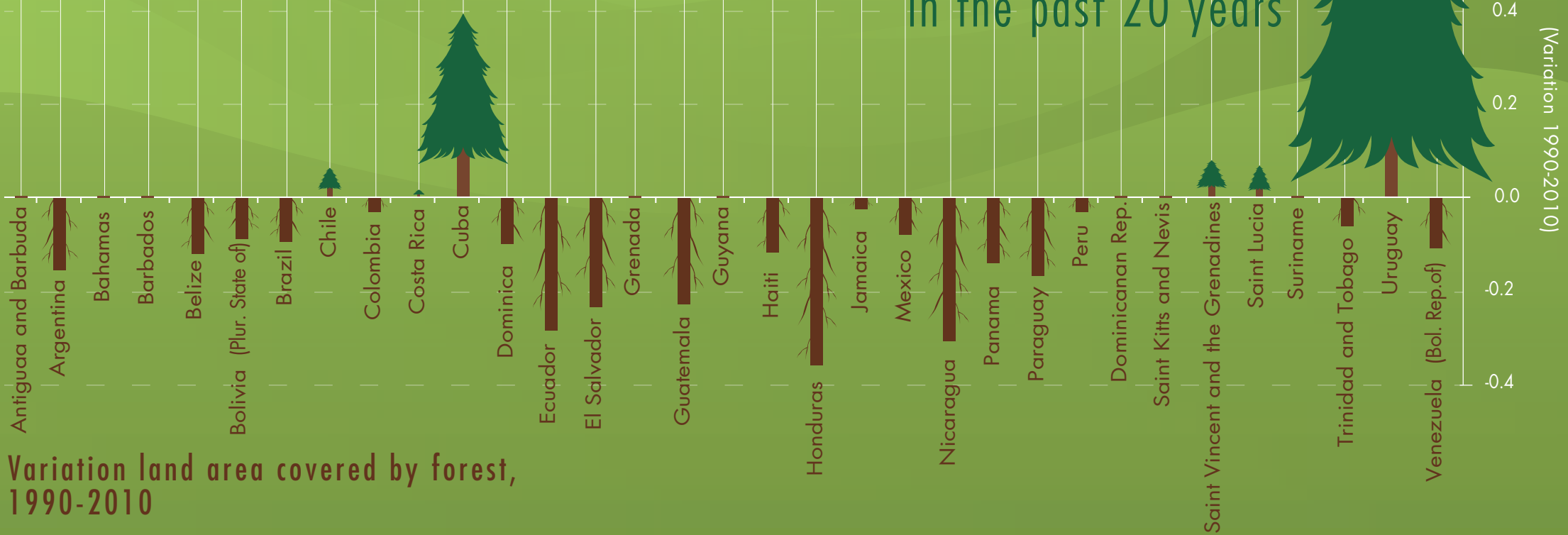
CO2 EMISSIONS have been ON THE RISE in LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN

Variation in CO2 emissions per capita, 1990-2010



Only four countries show a downward trend between 2000 Y 2010:
BELIZE, GUATEMALA, JAMAICA AND DOMINICANAN REPUBLIC

In addition, only 6 countries have increased their forest cover in the past 20 years
